• Direct US aid 1949-2001 totals \$84.5 billion unadjusted for inflation and cost of borrowing. Private donations total about \$1 billion annually from US.

• Hidden costs to US: Fluctuation in price of oil, military costs and casualties, boycott of American goods, diplomatic isolation

• Israeli economy (2000): GDP: \$112 billion, exports \$28.3 billion, imports \$35.2 (excluding military), major partners US, EU, India, Hong Kong, Japan, South Korea. **Population** (2001) 6.4 million of which 5.2 Jewish, 1.2 Arab.
